

With Federal funds the Missouri budget has just expanded to 14 Billion, a historical and record breaking amount. That budget is larger than the budget of the State of Illinois, and still in 2021 the Republican State legislature passed the biggest tax increase in Missouri history. Three times (3), a gas tax increase went to the vote of the people, once in 2014, 2016, 2018. All three times the language on the ballot failed to pass a vote of the people.

A vote in the Senate to support the gas tax violated three things: The Missouri Republican Platform Article 2 section 1 Paragraph 9 speaks about keeping taxes low. It also violates the platform in Article 4 section 2 paragraph 1, that talks about balancing the State budget without raising taxes. Paragraph 6 of the same section talks about the principle of the Hancock Amendment that relates to tax increases going to the vote of the people.

Some Senators are saying now that's a "volunteer tax" because the funds can be returned to you. I hope the sheet below will help you keep track of the information the State is requiring for documentation for a refund, until we get the tax repealed.
